SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	This terms English will be focused on a variety of books. We are starting off the term reading 'The Wild Robot'. The children will be writing some diary entries and some setting descriptions. We will then move on expanding our writing by creating some non-chronological reports and poetry. We will be learning different SPAG topics each day.
Mathematics	We will start this term by learning about multiplication and division, looking at how use column multiplication and short division. We will then move onto fractions where the children we discover how to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions. Please continue to encourage children to practice times tables on TT rockstars.
Science	Our topics in science this term are 'sound' and 'plants'. During our study of sound, we will be discussing how sound is created through vibrations. The children will also be involved in some experiments investigating sound levels across the school. We will then move onto plants where children will build on their knowledge from previous years.
Computing	This term year 4 will be learning about Data logging, and year 5 will be learning about Flat-file data bases.
PE	The children will have dance on Tuesdays with YTFC and netball on Thursdays with Bourne coaching. We are very lucky to have these external coaches coming into the school providing the children with many sporting opportunity.
Geography	Our topic this half term is 'Why are rivers so important?' We will be looking at the impact of Rivers, whilst also focusing on the water cycle, river features and river formation.
History	Our history topic this term is the 'Romans'. The children will be learning all about how the Roman Empire became so powerful due to their advancements in road and city building. We will also focus on how the Romans impacted Britain by looking at local sites such as Ham Hill.
RE	Our focus in RE is 'What helps people make good decisions?'. We will be looking at how religious and non-religious people are influenced to make good decisions. The children will be investigating what a good decision and reflecting on what they would do in different situations and thinking carefully about what influences their decisions.
PSHE	This term our topics are 'keeping safe' and 'rights and respect'. We will be looking into how we can keep ourselves safe in school and online.
D & T & ART	In DT this term the children will be making hand puppets, focusing on their sewing skills. In art this term, the children will be developing their watercolour skills to complete a river painting in the style of Monet.




GRAMMAR AND SPELLING

Children will take home 10 spellings to learn each week. These spellings will be linked to a spelling rule.

Spellings will be given on a Friday and children will be tested on these spellings the following Friday. They can also practise these spellings on Spelling Shed.

Children will be set grammar homework from their *CGP* book on a Friday. This needs to be handed in on the following Thursday.



READING

Children will take home books to read at home. They will be expected to read 4 times a week. Reading at home is to be recorded in their reading record books by parents/carers.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- ◆ Please ensure your child brings in their reading book and reading record every day.
- ◆ Homework is set on a Friday. Please help your child to complete their homework and return it to school the following Thursday.
- ◆ Please sign your child's reading record each time you hear them read.
- ◆ Our PE day is on a **Tuesday and Wednesday**. Please can children come to school in their PE kit on these days.
- ◆ We ask that your child does not bring in any toys, fidgets or pencil cases from home. The reason for this is that items usually become the source of conflict and/or upset because they get damaged, lost or "borrowed" by others.
- ◆ We encourage children to drink water regularly during the day and water bottles can be brought in daily and stored in our tray.
