Dear Parents

This letter is designed to provide key information about learning this term.

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	This terms English will be focused on a variety of books. We are starting off the term reading 'Who Let The Gods Out?'. The children will be writing persuasive speeches and character descriptions. The children will also have the opportunity to write non-chronological reports and newspaper reports. We will then move on to look at different texts including non-fiction and poetry. We will be learning different SPAG topics each day.
Spelling / Reading	Last year, the children really enjoyed our class texts, and we will continue to have an exciting class book that we will read together. Guided reading will be based on a range of texts, some linking to our topics and others independent. We will be focusing on reading skills and how to answer questions in reading tests. The children will be learning new spellings each week and we will help them learn them in class, as well as sending sheets home for them to practice.
Mathematics	We will start this term by learning about money and time, where the children will be improving their knowledge of decimals to add different amounts of money. We will then move on to statistics and shapes, ensuring the children can interpret a range of graphs and identify properties of shapes. Please continue to encourage children to practice times tables on TT rockstars.
Science	Our topics in science this term are 'Rocks' and 'Light'. During our study of the rocks, we will be investigating fossils by studying fossil sites in our local area and the animals fossilised.
Computing	This term we will be focusing on photo editing and making repetition games.
Geography	Our topic this half term is 'How is life different in Greece compared to the UK?' We will develop our map skills by identifying cities and identifying different terrains. We also look at the climate, physical features, and human features.
History	Our history topic this term is Ancient Greece where the children will be answering the enquiry questions 'What were the Greek city-states?' and 'What did Ancient Greeks teach us?'.
Religion and Worldviews	Our focus in Religion and Worldviews is 'Who was Muhammad and what was important to him?'. We will be looking who Muhammad is and why he is an important figure in Islam.
Music	This half term the children will be learning from a music specialist.
PSHE	This term our topics are 'Being my best' and 'Growing and Changing'. We will be looking into how we can show respect and representing ourselves. We will then be looking at how we are growing and changing.
D & T & ART	In DT this term the children will be making moving flags, focusing on the mechanics of movement. In art this term, the children will be creating clay sculptures inspired by the artist Kate Malone.
PE	The children will have PE on Wednesday and Friday where they will focus on Athletics and Dodgeball.
