18 stretches for over 4100 miles. It flows from
27 the Blue Nile and the White Nile confluence in
35 Sudan to its mouth at the Mediterranean Sea.



37 The Amazon

42 Flowing approximately 4000 miles, the
49 Amazon is the second-longest river in the
57 world. From its source in the Peruvian Andes,
64 it travels through six countries before reaching
70 its mouth in the Atlantic Ocean.

72 The Yangtze

80 The third-longest river in the world and the
88 longest in Asia, the Yangtze covers over 3900
96 miles. Its journey begins in the mountains of
106 Tibet and then it winds from west to east until
114 reaching its mouth at the East China Sea.
