Dear Parents and carers,

I hope you all had a wonderful summer holiday and are feeling refreshed and ready for the new school year! My name is Miss Poggiali, and I am excited to be working with your children as we embark on a year filled with learning, creativity, and new adventures. Here is what we will be learning this term.

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	This term's English will be focused on a variety of books. We are starting off the term reading 'The Lion, Witch and the Wardrobe'. The children will be writing setting descriptions and diary entries. The children will have the opportunity to write non-chronological reports and newspaper reports. We will then move on to look at different texts including non-fiction and poetry. We will be learning different SPAG topics each day.
Spelling / Reading	Last year, the children really enjoyed our class texts, and we will continue to have an exciting class book that we will read together. Guided reading will be based on a range of texts, some linking to our topics and others independent. We will be focusing on reading skills and how to answer questions in reading tests. The children will be learning new spellings each week and we will help them learn them in class, as well as sending sheets home for them to practice.
Mathematics	We will start this term by learning about place value, allowing them to learn key mathematical skills which can be applied to a range of topics. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, where children will develop mental and column addition and subtraction. Please continue to encourage children to practice times tables on TT rockstars.
Science	Our topics in science this term are 'Forces' and 'Magnets'. During our study of forces, we will be investigating pull and push forces and how different forces interact with one another.
Computing	This term we will be focusing on the internet and audio production.
Geography	Our topic this half term is 'How is life different in Italy compared to the UK?' We will develop our map skills by identifying cities and identifying different terrains. We also look at the climate, physical features, and human features.
History	Our history topic this term is Prehistory where the children will be answering the enquiry questions 'How did life change in Britain from the Stone Age to the Iron Age?' The children will also look at Burrow Hill and Ham Hill as local studies.
Religion and Worldviews	Our focus in Religion and Worldviews is 'How do we study worldviews?'. During this topic the children will explore what a worldview is and what different factors may influence people's worldviews.
Music	This half term the children will be learning from our music specialist teacher – Miss Stringer.
PSHE	This term our topics are 'Me and My Relationships' and 'Valuing differences'. We will be looking at ourselves and the people who are important to us. Then we will go onto exploring and valuing what makes us all different.
D & T & ART	In DT this term the children will be making Pizza, focusing on the key skills of kneading and baking. In art this term, the children will be painting Italian landscapes inspired by the artist Vincent Van Gogh.
PE	The children will have PE on Wednesday and Friday where they will focus on Tag Rugby and Hockey.
