



## Hambridge Community Primary School Curriculum Information

Dear Parents

This letter is designed to provide key information about learning this term.

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	This terms English will be focused on a variety of books. We are starting off the term reading 'The Journey'. The children will be writing predictions, describing characters and settings, and writing their own narrative to continue on from what they have read. We will then move on to look at different texts including non-fiction and poetry. We will be learning different SPAG topics each day.
Spelling / Reading	Last year, the children really enjoyed our class texts, and we will continue to have an exciting class book that we read at the end of each day. Guided reading will be based on a range of texts, some linking to our topics and others independent. We will be focusing on reading skills and how to answer questions in reading tests. The children will be learning new spellings each week and we will help them learn them in class, as well as sending sheets home for them to practice.
Mathematics	We will start this term by learning about place value, looking at how to write and read larger numbers and how to add and subtract different amounts. We will then move on to addition and subtraction, ensuring the children can use column method and mental math to solve problems. Please continue to encourage children to practice times tables on TT rockstars.
Science	Our topics in science this term are 'forces' and 'magnets'. During our study of forces, we will be discussing what a force is, and when we use force in our everyday life. The children will be taking part in an experiment to understand how friction effects items differently. Our topic on magnets will be focussing on magnetic forces, and how the different poles attract and repel.
Computing	This term year 4 will be learning about The Internet, and year 5 will be learning about communication and collaboration.
Geography	Our topic this half term is 'how is it different to live in Italy compared to the UK?'. We will be looking at similarities and differences between the two countries – looking at the climate, physical features, and human features.
History	Our history topic this term is 'How did the Roman Empire change Britain?'. The children will be learning all about The Romans and their links to our local areas. We will look at artefacts and discuss how Britain has changed due to the Roman Empire.
Religion and Worldviews	Our focus in RE is 'Community – Where is religion?'. We will be looking at how religion can affect communities and where religion is found in our community.
Music	This half term the children will be learning from a music specialist.
PSHE	This term our topics are Me and my relationships and valuing differences. We will be looking into different types of relationships in various parts of the children's lives and explore how to deal with a range of scenarios. We will then be looking at how we are all different and how differences make us special.
D & T & ART	In DT this term the children will be making pizzas, focusing on how to knead the dough. In art this term, the children will be making mosaics inspired by The Romans.
PE	The children will have cricket on Mondays, and fitness on Tuesdays.
