Dear Parents

This letter is designed to provide key information about learning this term.

SUBJECT	CONTENT
English	This terms English will be focused on a variety of books. We are starting off the term reading 'The Tin Forest'. The children will be writing predictions, describing characters and settings, and learning new grammar and punctuation skills. We will then be writing some poems relating to the text. We will be learning different SPAG topics each day.
Spelling / Reading	Last year, the children really enjoyed our class texts, and we will continue to have an exciting class book that we read at the end of each day. Guided reading will be based on a range of texts, some linking to our topics and others independent. We will be focusing on reading skills and how to answer questions in reading tests. The children will be learning new spellings each week and we will help them learn them in class, as well as sending sheets home for them to practice.
Mathematics	We will start this term by learning about multiplication and division, looking at how to multiply larger numbers and divide using different methods. We will then move on to fractions where the children will focus on counting in fractions, adding and subtracting fractions and how to change mixed numbers to improper fractions. Please continue to encourage children to practice times tables on TT rockstars.
Science	Our topics in science this term are: 'The Digestive System' and 'States of Matter'. During our study of the digestive system, we will be discussing what our digestive system does, how our teeth and animal teeth work to assist our digestion, and the different organs in the body that also assist with digesting food.
Computing	This term year 4 will be learning about data logging, and year 5 will be learning about spreadsheets and how to collect data to input into these.
Geography	Our topic this half term is 'Enough for Everyone'. We will be learning about what climate change is, and the effect it is having on the environment. We will also be learning about power stations and which types are best for the planet, alongside renewable/ non-renewable energy and food miles. Miss Reygate has booked a school trip to a reservoir/water treatment center for the summer term, to teach the children about how water can create energy, and the importance of not polluting our water.
History	In history, the children will be learning about Ancient Greece, and what the Ancient Greeks taught us.
RW	Our focus in RW is 'Faith in action'. We will be looking at how people have used their faith to lead them in their lives and inspired them to live a certain way.
Music	This half term the children will be learning from a music specialist.
PSHE	This term our topics are keeping myself safe and rights and respects. We will be looking into how children can keep themselves safe in a range of scenarios both inside and outside of school.
D & T & ART	In DT this term the children will be making bags, focusing on the hemming stitch. In art this term, the children will be making sculptures from recycled materials, focusing on the work of Andy Goldsworthy.
PE	The children will have swimming on Wednesdays and dance on Fridays.
